• Entombment:

Many cemeteries have walls which contain "niches". Niches usually have room for one or two sets of cremated remains. Southlawn provides affordable niches that allow two sets of cremated remains and are constructed of granite.

Keepsakes:

You may choose to keep a small portion of the cremated remains as a memento and then bury, scatter or entomb the balance. For this reason, jewelry and keepsake urns have become popular.
